BEYERSKLOOF

Beyerskloof has a small but modern cellar that, along with tasting room, had a face-lift very recently. Here you can do a wine tasting or have a glass of our wine along with a meal in our restaurant. The wine maker, Beyers Truter uses stainless steel roto-fermenter tanks for some of the Pinotage grapes to achieve the extra skin-juice contact that leads to improved colour and extraction levels. The grapes for the Cabernet-based Beyerskloof are still fermented in the old-fashioned way in open, concrete tanks. Beyerskloof was the first Cape wine to enjoy early maturation in 100% new barriques.

The specialist wine shop at The Vineyard Connection offers daily wine tastings and boasts more than 400 wines from the region and beyond. An olive deli, a pottery, an arts and crafts shop, and a wool shop selling unique, hand-knitted items as well as jewellery, are all worth a visit. Oakleaf Lodge provides affordable accommodation in a spacious farm house with a separate honeymoon suite.
